
Assumptions

Behaviors

- State views and ask genuine questions
- Share all relevant information
- Use specific examples and agree on the meaning of important words and concepts
- Explain reasoning and intent
- Focus on interests, not positions
- **Test assumptions** and inferences
- Jointly design next steps
- Discuss undiscussables!
- **Listening**

2. When were you at your best self in the Church and what was it that allowed that to happen?




3. What glimpses of our shared future compel you to offer your best self?
